



## Danish Language Course for Foreign University Students under the Cultural Agreements programme Copenhagen, 12 July – 1 August 2017

Application period: 16 January – 1 March 2017

## How to apply - Instruction and Information

The Summer Language Course in Danish is free of charge and open to bachelor, Master's and Ph.D. students enrolled in a full-degree program in one of the following countries or at the following universities:

- Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Repbulic, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malta, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, South Corea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, The Netherlands, and Turkey.
- University of British Columbia, Department of Central, Eastern and Northern European Studies, Vancouver, Canada; Portland State University, Dept. of Foreign Lang. and Literature, Portland, OR, USA; University of California, Department of Scandinavian Studies, Berkley, Ca, USA; University of California, The Scandinavian Section, Los Angeles, CA, USA; University of Colorado Boulder, the Department of Germanic and Slavic Languages and Literatures, Boulder, CO, USA; University of Texas at Austin, Department of Germanic Studies, Austin, TX, USA; University of Washington, Scandinavian Department, Seattle, WA, USA; University of Wisconsin, Department of Scandinavian Studies, Madison, WI, USA; Beijing Foreign Studies University, The Danish Department, Beijing, China; Fudan University, College of Foreign languages and Literatures, Shanghai, China; The Institute of European language and Culture, Beijing, China; Sino-Danish Centre for Education and Research (SDC), Beijing, China.

With the acceptance for the course follows a scholarship of DKK 5000, which will be handed out on the first day of the course.

Only students, who on March 1, 2017 are enrolled in a university as a full time student, can apply for the scholarship.

Please note that applications sent to more than one institution as first priority will not be accepted.

This summer course is offered by the Danish Cultural Institute in co-operation with the Copenhagen Center for Adult Education (KVUC). The course administrator is the Danish Cultural









Institute, Vartov, Farvergade 27 L, 1463 Copenhagen K. The teaching takes place at KVUC, Vognmagergade 8, 1120 Copenhagen K in the city centre of Copenhagen with perfect study facilities, modern IT-equipment. At the very same period about 600 Danish students follow classes at KVUC - to improve their knowledge and skills in specific subjects/ levels required by the university.

A list of accommodation facilities including dormitory will be mailed together with letter of acceptance.
