

**Danish Language Course for Foreign University Students
under the Cultural Agreements Programme
Copenhagen, 10 - 30 July, 2019**

Application period: 14 January – 1 March 2019, at 23:59 CET

Students can apply for a scholarship under the Cultural Agreements programme to attend a Danish Summer Language Course. The summer language course in Danish is open to bachelor's, master's and ph.d. students, who at the time of applying are enrolled in full-degree programmes in institutions of higher education in one of the following country groups:

The summer course is offered by Danish Cultural Institute in cooperation with the Copenhagen Center for Adult Education (KVUC). The course administrator is Danish Cultural Institute, Vartov, Farvergade 27 L, 1463 Copenhagen K. The teaching takes place at KVUC, Sankt Petri Passage 1, 1165 Copenhagen K, in the centre of Copenhagen with perfect study facilities and modern IT-equipment.



At the very same period about 600 Danish students follow classes at KVUC - to improve their knowledge and skills in specific subjects/ levels required by the university.

How to apply

The application must be filled out ELECTRONICALLY on a computer in either Danish or English. Incomplete and handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.

Important: Applications sent to more than one institution as first priority will not be accepted.

Deadline for applying is 1 March 2019, at 11.59 CET.

How do we prioritize:

- Students between 19-35 years of age
- Students who study Danish or Danish culture, preferably for 1 semester and have acquired communication skills in Danish
- Students at Bachelor's or Master's level
- Students with family ties in Denmark and a certain knowledge of Danish Country and cultural diversity
- Students going to study in Denmark under the Erasmus+ Programme
- Students who plan to study in Denmark

Outcome of application

In April you will receive an e-mail with the outcome of your application.

Accepted students receive free tuition and a scholarship of 5,000 DKK as a supplement to cover room and board. Please note that students must cover all travel expenses and other personal expenses (Meals, shopping, gifts, souvenirs, etc.) by themselves.

We can offer a certain number of single and shared double rooms at a student hotel at a favorable price from July 9-31. Information will be mailed together with the letter of acceptance.
